
<u>Thriving Queensland Kids Partnership</u> (TQKP) is a movement of people and organisations working to transform systems so all young Queenslanders can thrive. As part of its <u>2025 - 2030 Strategy</u>, with the support of Minderoo Foundation, TQKP will be building capability and innovation amongst selected Queensland hubs to June 2027.

The Queensland Hubs Exchange of Expertise and Learning Initiative provides Queensland hubs the opportunity to access connections, knowledge, skills and strategies by applying for one or more of the following four opportunities across two streams:

Capability Innovation Building Immersion Innovation Groups e.g. visits to other hubs to share learning and to collectively develop and test solutions to develop practice through peer-to-peer system challenges as referenced in the learning Queensland Child and Family Hubs Framework **Accessing Capability** e.g. through accessing free training, peer mentoring, coaching, community of practice **Delivering Capability** e.g. through funding to deliver training, peer mentoring, coaching, community of practice

We are inviting expressions of interest (EOI) from child and family hubs in Queensland (established, under development or in the planning stages) to take up this opportunity. Submissions are encouraged from groups, including via a lead organisation or geographical group of hubs.
