Why is this survey being conducted?

Queensland Kids Partnership (QKP) is running this survey to inform our Monitoring, Evaluation, Learning and Reporting (MELR) framework. Your feedback helps us improve how we work together to achieve better outcomes for Queensland's children and young people. De-identified results, including quotes, may be shared in QKP reports or online.

What does participation involve?

Participation in this survey is voluntary. It takes about 10 minutes, with mostly multiple-choice and rating questions plus a few optional comment boxes. Some questions are required to continue, but many are optional – you can skip any question you do not wish to answer. Your decision whether or not to take part (or to skip questions) will not affect your relationship with QKP or ARACY.

You may withdraw from the survey at any time before you submit it. To withdraw, simply close your browser. If you stop halfway, we may still use the answers you have provided up to that point, unless you contact us to exclude them. Once you have submitted the survey, your responses cannot be withdrawn or deleted.

Benefits and risks of participating

There is no direct personal benefit to you from completing this survey. However, your insights will help QKP and our partners reflect and improve how we work together – which may indirectly benefit organisations like yours as we strive for positive systems change for children and families. We do not expect any risks from participation.

Privacy and confidentiality

Your privacy is important to us. You can complete the survey anonymously or provide your name and contact details if you are open to follow-up contact with QKP. If you do share your name, it will only be seen by the QKP team. We might mention general details like your region or sector when reporting findings, but we will not identify you by name without permission.

All data will be stored securely on password-protected systems. We will retain the data for at least seven years, after which it will be securely deleted.

By completing and submitting the survey, you indicate you have read this information and agree to participate. No separate consent form is needed – your survey submission serves as consent.
